General Rules

- Registration process will be closed 30 minutes before the commencement of each event.
- Decisions of the jury will be final and binding for all events.
- ❖ Any or all the rules are subject to change at any point of time.
- Participation certificates will be provided to all the registered participants.
- ❖ Students interested in taking part in the events should register on the day of the carnival at the registration committee.
- There is no registration fee.
- A participant can participate in any number of events as long as the event timings do not clash. In case of simultaneous timings of events, a participant can only participate in one of the clashing events.
- ❖ All the events will commence at the scheduled time. Punctuality will be appreciated.
- ❖ All the participants should be in proper school uniform.
- All participants should have proper ID card for proof of date of birth and should be able to produce the same in original when asked for verification, failing which they will not be considered for any award and the prize will be awarded to the participant next in the merit list.
- Use of any unfair means will lead to disqualification.
- ❖ Participants must maintain COVID protocol



Event: Quiz

Eligibility Criteria for Participating the Quiz Event - Class 8 to 12

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. Each team should contain a maximum of two participants.
- 3. An initial screening round on general knowledge will be conducted to select six teams for final rounds of quiz competition.
- 4. A total of four rounds will be conducted out of which two teams will be eliminated after the first two rounds.
- 5. Questions for the different rounds will be based on current affairs, audio visual clips, sports, mythology, culture, movies and music.
- 6. Winner, first runner up and second runner up prizes will be given to the participants along with participation certificates to all.

Event: Extempore

Eligibility Criteria for Participating the Extempore Event:

- Junior Class 6 to 8
- Senior Class 9 to 12

Extempore means without planning or preparation. In this event, a candidate is asked to speak briefly on a given topic without preparation beforehand. Clarity of thought, range of knowledge, presence of mind and fluency of a candidate are generally examined in an Extempore.

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. Participants may speak in any of the three languages, ENGLISH, BENGALI or HINDI.
- 3. Each participant will be given 4 minutes to speak on a topic.
- 4. Topics will be randomly selected by means of lottery.
- 5. A maximum of 30 seconds may be given to a candidate for preparation after knowing the topic mentioned in the lottery chit.
- 6. A participant will be allowed to select the topic once only.
- 7. Participants will not be allowed to take any paper or material with them.
- 8. Participation certificates will be given to all participants.

Judgement:

- 1. Judges will look for clarity of thought, range of knowledge, presence of mind, effective use of language, and body language.
- 2. The decision of the Jury Panel will be final and binding.
- 3. First, second and third place winners will be awarded mementos and certificates.

Event: State Level Chess Tournament

Eligibility Criteria for Event: State Level Chess Tournament

[Separate events for Boys & Girls]

- Junior Class 6 to 8
- Senior Class 9 to 12

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. Registration will be done on a first come first serve basis and Maximum 150 200 players are allowed to participate the event.
- 3. System: The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with 5 or 6 rounds.
- 4. Time Control: Session 40 Min. (Each 20 Min.)
- 5. Electronic Devices: All electronic items including all types of wrist-watches are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- 6. The Chief Arbiter's decision is final and binding on all.
- 7. Withdrawal: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
- 8. The decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding on all parties in all matters pertaining to the tournament.
- 9. Students should maintain discipline.

Eligibility Criteria for Event: Inter School Cricket Tournament

[9 Players per Team]

Class 6 to 12

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. The basic rules of short cricket are applicable for this event.
- 3. Each team should consist of 9 players.
- 4. All Players of the team should be considered from same school
- 5. Each team should carry their own bats, while the College will provide tennis balls only during matches.
- 6. Each innings will have a maximum of 6 overs play.
- 7. Umpire's decision is final.
- 8. Players can hit and score 4; hitting 6 is not allowed. If anyone hits 6, it will be considered as out.

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).

- 3. Other necessary materials like pencil, rubber, colour etc. are to be brought by individual participants. Any medium of colouring is welcome viz. watercolour/pastel/coloured pencil, pencil shading etc.
- 4. Use of any kind of pen (sketch/fountain/gel/highlighter etc.) is strictly not allowed to draw/colour. However, it can be used only for writing captions/messages/comments etc. in the drawing sheet.
- 5. All participants will be awarded a certificate of participation along with a small refreshment packet.
- 6. There will be three winners (1st, 2nd & 3rd place) and they will be awarded with Memento and Winners Certificate.
- 7. Decisions of the Jury Panel will be final and binding.

Event: Model Display

Eligibility Criteria for Event: Model Display

- Junior Class 6 to 8
- Senior Class 9 to 12

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. Maximum number of 4 participants are allowed per team.
- 3. Each team should display their model throughout the event schedule. Failing this, a team may be liable for disqualification.
- 4. Participants should bring their requirements (Extension cord etc.) with them on the day of the event.
- 5. The decision of the judges will be final and no dispute will be entertained.
- 6. Rules may be changed without prior notice to the participants.

Event: Carrom Tournament

Eligibility Criteria for Event: Carrom Tournament

- Junior Class 6 to 8
- Senior Class 9 to 12

Rules:

- 1. All participants should have a valid ID proof (School ID Card).
- 2. Red is not allowed in hit stroke.
- 3. Always due fine considered if there is no available coins (the carrom pieces).
- 4. At the stroke time if any player's body touches any coins and then the coin is pocketed, then two coins considered as fine.
- 5. If any player touches any moving coin or striker after the stroke then single coin is considered as fine.
- 6. For single line, one coin is considered as fine.
- 7. Single fine and double fine as considered for one coin and two coin.
- 8. The judgement will decided after 3 boards.
- 9. Push at the time of stroke considered as a fine of single coin.
- 10. Shoulder and elbows must always stay outside of the playing board area.
- 11. Playing outside the proper zone is considered as a fine of one coin.
- 12. After one stroke is taken, the next stroke must be taken within 30 seconds.
- 13. Any issues of jumping of coins will be decided by the judges.
- 14. Player can play using both hands.
- 15. If any player use personal striker then it must be verified before playing by the judge.
- 16. The decision of judge is final and binding. The match structure will be decided on the day of the event by the organizers. No disputes will be entertained.
