Short Term Perspective Plans

- To get NAAC accreditation for the college by 2025: The institute will formally apply to the NAAC by submitting the IIQA as soon as possible and then follow subsequent steps. The Self-Study Report (SSR) will be prepared under the guidance of the Coordinator, IQAC and the Principal.
- To enhance Teaching and Learning environment in the institute: To augment the learner-centric facilities, the institute intends to develop smart classrooms equipped with cutting edge technology. The institute's main goal is to improve teaching and learning processes by expanding the availability of interactive tools. Enhancing the online teaching and learning resources will be another priority for the institute.
- To enhance the quality of research publications: The institute places a strong emphasis on teachers and students submitting research papers in reputed journals. The institute intends to offer teachers and students incentives and support for publishing research articles in reputed journals on a national as well as global scale.
- Faculty development programmes and conferences: The institute will encourage the faculty members to attend different Faculty development programmes and conferences.
- To improve the infrastructural facilities in the institute: The infrastructure of the college will be upgraded in accordance with the recommendations made by the relevant committees depending upon specific requirements of upgradation.
- To conduct Academic and Administrative Audit periodically: The institute will continue to undertake its regular academic audits in order to maintain the general standard and keep an eye on its educational offerings.

- To collect different feedbacks properly and to actions accordingly: In addition to collecting the student's feedback on performance of faculty members and technical assistants, feedback on academic ambience and facilities will also be collected from the stake holders. After collecting the feedbacks, it will be analysed properly and necessary corrective action will be taken accordingly.

Additionally, the institute intends to encourage students to enroll for various internship programs. - To enhance the engagement with society: The institute will focus on increasing the extension activities and social engagements through NSS unit of the college.
- Measures for mental and physical wellbeing: To focus on the mental and physical wellbeing of the students and the staff, the institute will take possible and necessary measures.
- To enhance interactions with alumnae: The institute will take necessary steps so that alumni interaction with present students can be increased through appropriate events on regular basis.
